### Measuring Evidence with p-values - Montgomery College

A p-value is the chance of getting a statistic as extreme as that observed, if  $H_0$  is true • A p-value can be calculated as the proportion of statistics in the randomization distribution as extreme as the observed sample statistic • The smaller the p-value, the greater the evidence against  $H_0$
